Teachers

- Divide students into groups with a chaperone leader
- Know where your students are at all times
- Communicate behavior expectations and details to students and chaperones:
 - Computer use- YES or NO?
 - Can students check out books?
 - Rally point and time for bus loading/lunch

Chaperones

- Stay with your group of students at all times
- Model expected behavior
- Remind students of their jobs
- Help students find and check out books
- Return students to bus rally point on time

Students

- Walking feet and indoor voices
- Stay to the right when using stairs
- Return books to any table or cart
- Stay with your group & chaperone
- Tidy up after crafts, activities, and lunch

Library Staff

- Welcome and orientation
- Help students find books or research info
- Answer questions about books, cards, and services
- Provide educational exploration activities
- Gather resources to support assignments
